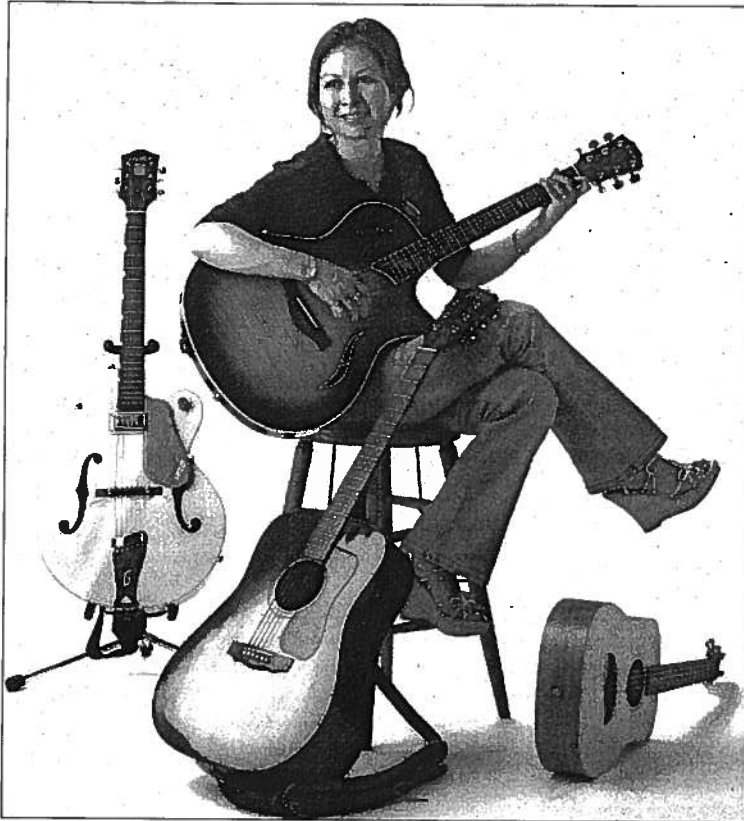


Lawyers are beautiful too

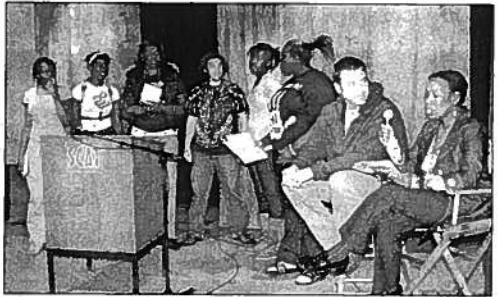
